3. Curriculum

3.01 Report on 2019-2020 School Improvement Plans - Mr. Bennett reported on the Elementary Plan. There are three main goals they are focusing on, one in language arts, one in math and one for attendance. This is reviewed about four times during the school year. The Jr/Sr High School was identified as a school that needed a comprehensive improvement plan. Mr. Carlin explained the goals are similar to the education with language arts and math goals to increase proficiency and the percentage of students earning high growth.

4.01 Recommendation to approve 2019-2020 School Improvement Plans

- 5.02 Ron Gifford from Starke County Economic Development Mr. Gifford made a presentation regarding Economic Development in Starke County. He highlighted the courses offered at SCILL, demographics of the area along with economic developments and issues in the county. Jobs, housing and the time zone continue to be challenges for jobs and schools in the area.
- 5.03 State Representative Jim Pressel and State Senator Bohacek were in attendance to address the board on some of the challenges facing local schools. There was a good back and forth discussion between Rep. Pressel and Senator Bohacek with the Board asking questions pertaining to school funding. Other items discussed again included jobs, housing and the time zone.
